## GiGi's takes Wrigley Field by Storm!

When the Chicago Cubs and the Players Give Back Program asked GiGi's if they would like tickets for the August 19th game, little did they know that GiGi's would fill up almost 650 seats! The Cubs Care Foundation has been a supporter of the Chicago GiGi's Playhouse for the last 2 years. Their generous grants have allowed GiGi's to offer free educational and therapeutic programming including tutoring for hundreds of children and adults with Down syndrome! With 650 people, we had to turn it into awareness event so we ordered blue GiGi's foam fingers for each person to wave! On August 19th, for the first Hope Week Event at Wrigley Field, more than 650 GiGi's families entered Wrigley Field – all holding big blue foam fingers!

GiGi walked onto the field with some of her friends and waved to the crowd as all the Hope Week organizations were announced. Here is a quote from one mom that took 4 kids to the game by herself, "Wow! This was amazing! It gave me the confidence to know that I can do this! I always thought that it would be too hard to bring all my kids out at the same time but this proves that I can! Thank you!" The Cubs may have lost that game but in the words of Harry Carey, Holy Cow, were we able to spread awareness!
